
Morse Bluff North Bend Area Veterans Memorial Park



Dedicated to the men and women who have honorably served our nation in the Armed Forces, during peacetime and war, so we might enjoy the freedoms we have today.


THE VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK
was first conceptualized in the summer of
2002. In the following months,
individuals and the 3 Military Service
Organizations were contacted and asked
to help develop plans for the Park. The
VFW, American Legion and Am Vets
are currently engaged in building this
Veterans Memorial Park in North Bend,
Nebraska. This project is a mutual effort
by the communities of North Bend and
Morse Bluff. The purpose of the park is to
honor all veterans who served in the
Armed Forces, during peace and war.

Eight bronze sculptures created by Fred Hoppe, Jr. will represent the six military branches: Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, Merchant Marines, and Navy.

A primary flagpole will display the American Flag along with three supplementary flagpoles to display the flags of the three veterans' organizations.



Five black granite benches along with planters, trees, and shrubs will enhance the beauty of the park, encouraging visitors to sit, relax, and remember.




